Ed started pitching horseshoes on the farm near Plymouth, Mi. Ed started pitching on clay courts in 1982 in the state of Florida. ED also joined the NHPA at this time and started pitching in tournaments. He pitched in about 18 tournaments a year for 10 years.

Ed pitched in a sanctioned league in Florida and accomplished the following:
