The 2023 schedule has come out, is on the website, and there are many opportunities to get your tournaments in to qualify for the first World Horseshoe Tournament ever in Michigan. We would like to again thank Jason Castle for joining our association and hosting tournaments in Lapeer. Our first two indoor tournaments have been full houses over a week early, so there is much excitement for the Worlds.

The dates of play at the 2023 World Horseshoe Tournament are July 17 through July 29. The deadline for entries is May 17 for the World tournament.

Repeating the next two paragraphs from the last Ringer Report: I will be around to the courts this coming year to resanction the facilities. We have lost Brighton and Holt in the last year, and have regained Lapeer. Inactive facilities in Hillsdale, Lincoln Park and Manton can be re-sanctioned if a new tournament director steps up to head these clubs.

In this coming year, the tournament directors will be provided the token numbers to send the results to EShoe. There is no reason for TD's to send the results to the statistician when it is easier and potentially more accurate to have the TD's send them directly in to EShoe. The tournament directors will also be asked to send the results overview report to the webmaster, the Secretary/Treasurer and the Ringer Report editor. The statistician can then get the data for year-end reports from EShoe later, and work with the Secretary/Treasurer to resolve any issues.

I am pitching in a league in Florida this winter and I know that the World Tournament even gets notice down here. We are looking at a big event! As Josh learns things, he will ask for help from us. Step up and be someone, it is worth it.

Please remember to be kind to those tournament directors who have stepped up to run the winter tournaments. It's a bit of work, and can be quite thankless, but a kind word can make a big difference.

As a final note: Dean Schmitz has done some real good work since resuming the Ringer Report. When you all see him, give him some thanks.
