August 17th; or you can call (734)- 323-9116 (Mark Burns), for your pitching times.


- Membership meeting will be held on Saturday afternoon/evening

# BYLAW PROPOSALS



## Proposed Bylaw change requests that shall be voted on this year

#### **Article VI: Tournaments**

Currently Reads: Section 3 - District tournaments under jurisdiction of the MHPA shall start at 9:30 a.m. All participating members must be signed in by that time.

**Proposed Change:** All District tournaments (indoor and outdoor) shall now be pre-registration. Each participant must contact the host tournament director by the Wednesday before the scheduled tournament. Morning shift participants must be signed in with the tournament director by 9:00 a.m. and the afternoon shift by 1:00 p.m. Tournament will be begin at 9:30 a.m. for morning and 1:30 p.m. for the afternoon.

Reasoning for Change: This change will allow the tournament director to assign players to their classes and post the seedings on the MHPA social media outlets by Friday evening before the tournament (participants can also call the tournament director for seedings). This will also eliminate the need for all pitchers to report early, just to wait to play in the afternoon shift of the tournament. Our pitchers will be able to better plan for their pitching day by knowing their pitching schedule in advance of the tournament. The current odd and event date schedule will remain the same (odd – lower % and even -higher %).

Proposed Change: Entry fees for Indoor and Outdoor district tournaments shall be \$20.00 (minimum). The MHPA Executive Council will be responsible for defining and publishing minimum payouts for both Indoor and Outdoor district tournaments.

Reasoning for Change: This adjustment in the tournament entry fee will allow for an increased payout for our participants and by reducing the number of places paid out, that will also increase the payouts. There had not been an increase in the tournament entry fee in many years. \*\*There was also a change in the fees that were being paid to the Jackson Horseshoe Club for utilities/ use of the facility. The fee was previously \$8/player and is being reduced to \$6/player. This will allow some additional money to be paid out.\*\*

#### **Article VI: Tournaments**

**Currently Reads: Section 5** - The scorekeeping fee for all tournaments shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) per player per game, including juniors.

**Proposed Change:** The scorekeeping fee for all tournaments shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) per player per game, including juniors. Scheduling of the scorekeepers will be handled by the tournament director.

Reasoning for Change: If the bylaw change proposal passes to make all tournaments pre-registration and split report times, tournament directors will need to "assign" scorekeepers to be sure that the tournament can run as planned.

Proposal submitted by: President's Review Committee

#### **Article VI: Tournaments**

Currently Reads: Section 11 - All MHPA sanctioned tournaments shall be 35 point cancellation. Exception: Any game at a state singles tournament between two pitchers with a 25% or lower ringer percentage shall play to 30 points or 40 shoes, whichever occurs first. Any game at a district tournament between two pitchers with a 25% or lower ringer percentage shall play to 30 points or 40 shoes, whichever occurs first. In case of a tie game the pitchers shall pitch down and back (four shoes) until a winner is decided.

**Proposed Change:** All MHPA sanctioned tournaments will be 40 shoes. Games that are tied at the 40 shoe limit will remain a tie (each player will receive .5 credit for the game)

Reasoning for Change: If the bylaw change proposal for the split shift of our tournaments passes, we will need to move to the 40 shoe games to ensure that our tournaments stay on the time schedule that is proposed.

#### NHPA RULES/REGULATIONS GUIDELINES

Currently Reads: RULE 12 - APPROPRIATE NHPA MEMBER CONDUCT – Section D - Alcohol, Tobacco Products, and Illegal Controlled Substances

During the World and State Championship Tournaments, the use of alcohol, any form of tobacco, or illegal controlled substances while in the confines of the courts shall be prohibited for all contestants, officials, and scorekeepers. This rule may also be adopted into any Charter Bylaws or may be enforced at any local tournament, if announced in advance by the Tournament/League Officials. Violations may result in the forfeiture of games.

**Proposed Change:** MHPA tournament participants will be allowed to place their beverages (non-alcoholic/alcoholic) behind the backboard on the courts. Beverages must be in a covered container and not be glass.

Reasoning for Change: This will reduce the amount of time that participants are spending away from the courts to get their beverages, if the proposed bylaw change about new split reporting times passing, staying on schedule will be crucial.

#### In Article VII: State Tournament

Section 1 states "To qualify for the State Singles Tournament a MHPA member must have completed four sanctioned events within Michigan, from the previous State Singles Tournament."



#### The league is over 50 years old and has about 100 members.

Right off Lewis Street is where the Jackson County Horseshoe Club practices its pitches. Jus Perticone is one of the original members of the league that started in 1971. Perticone reminisces, "One year, we hosted the tournament here, and they had world champions!"

For over 50 years, pitchers from all over have come to play at these courts that Jus helped bring to Jackson. "We had tournaments here that were the biggest in the state. We had over 80 guys. For a local weekend tournament, that was fantastic," says Perticone.

Having some titles of his own, Perticone has stuck with the sport for one reason: competition. He says, "I like this sport because it's competitive, and how can you be 90- some years old and still be able to play in a sport where you're still competitive?

Perticone inspires other pitchers in the league. Another player, Marsha Watson, says, "I watch his technique; I realize he has thrown thousands and thousands of shoes." She continues, "He's here every week. He keeps up with the 20-year-olds. He's beat me before.

Even at 96, he hasn't let his love for the sport waver. "To be active, I don't know how it's going to be if I don't pitch. I'll be thinking about it," says Perticone.
