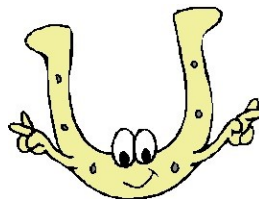

All Entries must be on this signed form and mailed with a **postmark no later than June 8th, 2021**. You may enter at anytime prior to June 8th, 2021. Entries received with a postmark after June 8th, 2021 shall be put on a waiting list and entered into the tournament only as space is available. All adults must have pitched in a minimum of two (2) US/Canadian sanctioned events in the twelve (12) months **prior to June 8th, 2021**, in the same division you are entering. Only one (1) event is required for Juniors. Exceptions for US Armed Forces members and family and foreign competitors (other than Canadians) are outlined in Rule 11, Sec D.1 of the RGS Book. Contact NHPA for more information regarding qualifying exceptions. All averages used will be the average on record in eShoe/ CANSTATS as of June 8th, 2021. Anyone qualifying under an exception must have those scores recorded by the same date. All NHPA and any special tournament rules apply. NHPA and CANADIAN entrants must provide identification by sanction card, or other form of ID, when checking in. Please see note regarding refunds.
READ CAREFULLY: Any adult male pitching from the full distance platform may enter the **OPEN MEN'S DIVISION** regardless of age, just as any adult female may enter the **OPEN WOMEN'S DIVISION**. To enter the **SENIOR DIVISION**, you must be 60 years of age or older before the end of 2021. Any man that turns 70 years of age in 2021, is older than 70, or has an **approved medical exemption** may enter the **ELDER MEN'S DIVISION**. Entrants in the **JUNIOR BOY and JUNIOR GIRL DIVISION** must be 18 years old or less for the entire 2021 calendar year. **CADET BOY AND CADET GIRL DIVISION** entrants must be 12 years old or younger for the entire 2021 calendar year.
Note # 1. 30ft Men with Medical Exemptions must be in eshoe as exempt to pitch in this division.
Note # 2. For class play, a minimum of 48 must enter this division or it will be canceled. All entrants will then pitch in the Open Preliminaries.
Note # 3 Junior Boys & Junior Girls divisions will be mixed for preliminary play. Cadet Boys & Cadet Girls divisions will be mixed for Preliminary play. For Championship play a min of 8 must enter this division or it will be canceled. The pitching schedule will be finalized by **June 12th, 2021** and published on the NHPA website. If you indicated above to receive the schedule by mail, it will be mailed to the address you have listed above during the second week in June.

FULL MEMBER – Dues for full adult members are the National dues of twenty- five dollars (\$25.00) plus the amount set for State dues within their Charter. Three dollars (\$3.00) of every adult membership will be set aside for the World Tournament prize fund, for the next year. Only full members may enter State and World tournament.

_____ FULL MEMBER (\$45.00): Voting member will full privileges to entry all sanctioned tournaments upon paying fees.

PROVISIONAL MEMBER – Dues for provisional adult members are the National Provisional dues of ten dollars (\$10.00). Provisional members are allowed to entry to regular tournaments/leagues (upon paying their full entry fee) for the period beginning at their first entry to the end of the current calendar year. At which time they must become full members in order to continue participating in NHPA tournaments/leagues. During their provisional time, a member can upgrade to full member at any time by paying the remainder of their National dues of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) and their state charter dues. Provisional member tournament/league statistics are reported to the NHPA. Provisional members cannot vote and do not count toward the awarding of charter delegates, but are reported on charter membership reports to the NHPA.

_____ PROVISIONAL MEMBER (\$10.00): Must pay entry fees and can play in as many tournaments as you like for the year.

TRIAL MEMBER – All dues for trial members are waived and the member is allowed entry to one regular tournament/league (upon paying their full entry fee). Trail member tournament/league statistics are not reported to the NHPA. Trail members cannot vote and do not count toward the awarding of charter delegates, but are reported on charter membership reports to the NHPA.

_____ TRIAL MEMBER (\$0.00): Must pay tournament entry fee and allowed only one tournament.
