John has been a member of the NHPA and MHPA since 1992.

John is a right handed pitcher and pitches a flip shoe at 30 feet and averages 40%

John and wife Mary have been married 53 years. They have three children, Christy, John Jr. (deceased) and Bill. They also have three grandchildren, Jennifer, Johnathon and Joseph, also three great grandchildren, Javon, Tiahna and Kylah.

John was born in St. Louis, MI, served in the Army and retired from GM.

John has attended most of the State Tournaments and has helped at most anything that needed to be done. He is well known for being the premier judge at the state tournaments.
