Terry started pitching horseshoes while in Sebring, Florida in 2002 at Buttonwood Bay in their league. Terry jointed the NHPA and MHPA the next year while in Michigan.

Terry is right handed and pitches a flip shoe.

Terry has been married to her husband Bod for 45 plus years and has two sons, Jim and Lee. She also has three grandchildren. Her husband Bob has been her coach since she started pitching.

Terry started her pitching career by pitching in the Michigan/Ontario Friendship Tournament at Kalamazoo. They pitched in this tournament for the next seven years until the competition ended. Her and Bob pitched in the State Doubles this year and Terry won her first class championship in the State Tournament. She won a Class C trophy and Tournament patch.

Terry received the most improved twice, once in 2004 and again in 2007. Also in this year her and Bob picked up the reins of the Team World Tournament at Beloit, Wisconsin and is still attending this tournament at the present time. They placed second this year after leading the whole way, they lost in a play-off.

Terry pitched a perfect game in Jackson on September 22, 2007, one of only two pitched in Michigan all time.

Terry has pitched in the Six-Pac Invitational and Hall of Fame Invitational at Wentzville, Missouri seven out of the last eight years representing the state of Michigan. Terry won the Class A Senior State Singles title in 2009 in Taylor, MI. She has pitched in two Pro Tours, she pitches in 30 to 35 NHPA tournaments a year and pitches at the Hillsdale Fair. So far to date she has won 68 first place tournament patches.

Terry has pitched in eleven World Tournaments and qualified for the championship group six times. She placed seventh this last year; that means she is seventh in the world in the women's group. She and Bob have traveled over most of the United States pitching horseshoes. She has pitched in 17 different states and Canada.

Terry pitches at the Highland County Horseshoe Club in Sebring, FL and has a tournament named after her. It is called the Terry Beagle Open. Terry and Bob put on a horseshoe demonstration at the Tecumseh Library this last year. Terry has been the Women's State Champion for the last four years.

Terry has been instrumental in starting the Hall of Fame and Museum at the Jackson County Horseshoe club building in Jackson
