2019 State Tournament Information

Can you believe that the spring/summer pitching season is upon us? No, well we can't either, but ready or not, here it comes! And with that, comes the start of preparations for the State Singles Tournament to be held on Friday, August 23 - Sunday, August 25 at the Jackson Horseshoe

Club.

Based on the results of the player surveys that were completed at the end of the tournament last year, we have decided to implement the following plan for this year's tournament.

1. The exact time assignments will be determined on Sunday, August 18. The schedule will then be posted on the website or you can contact President Mark Burns for your assignment.

2. Class assignments will be a bit different than in the past couple of years, when possible and competitive, we will be separating the 40' men and the 30' men/women. However, there maybe classes that will be mixed to ensure the most competitive class play for most.

- 3. We will be having preliminary class play on Friday evening with a start time of about 7 p.m.
- 4. Preliminary class play will continue on Saturday morning beginning at 8 a.m.
- 5. Here is a sample of what a pitching schedule could look like

Friday Night pitching groups @ 7 p.m. will pitch again at Saturday at 2 p.m.

Saturday morning pitching groups @ 8 a.m. will pitch their second round at 8 a.m. on Sunday

Saturday morning pitching groups @ 11 a.m. will pitch their second round at 11 a.m. on Sunday

- 6. We will have a dinner and the membership meeting on Saturday evening at the conclusion of the class play.
- 7. The Championship round for Men, Women, and Elders will take place on Sunday with a start time of 2:30 p.m.

8. The playing format will be 40 shoe limit games. The championship round games will not be a shoe limit. They will be 40 point cancellation games.

9. Remember, per on By-laws, Article VII: State Tournament—Section 4.

While pitching, all participants of the State Singles Tournament shall wear a shirt or blouse with their last name professionally lettered on the back.
